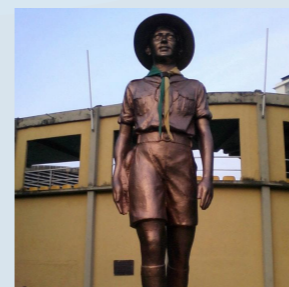

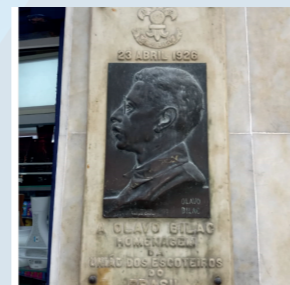

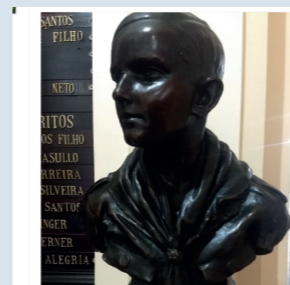

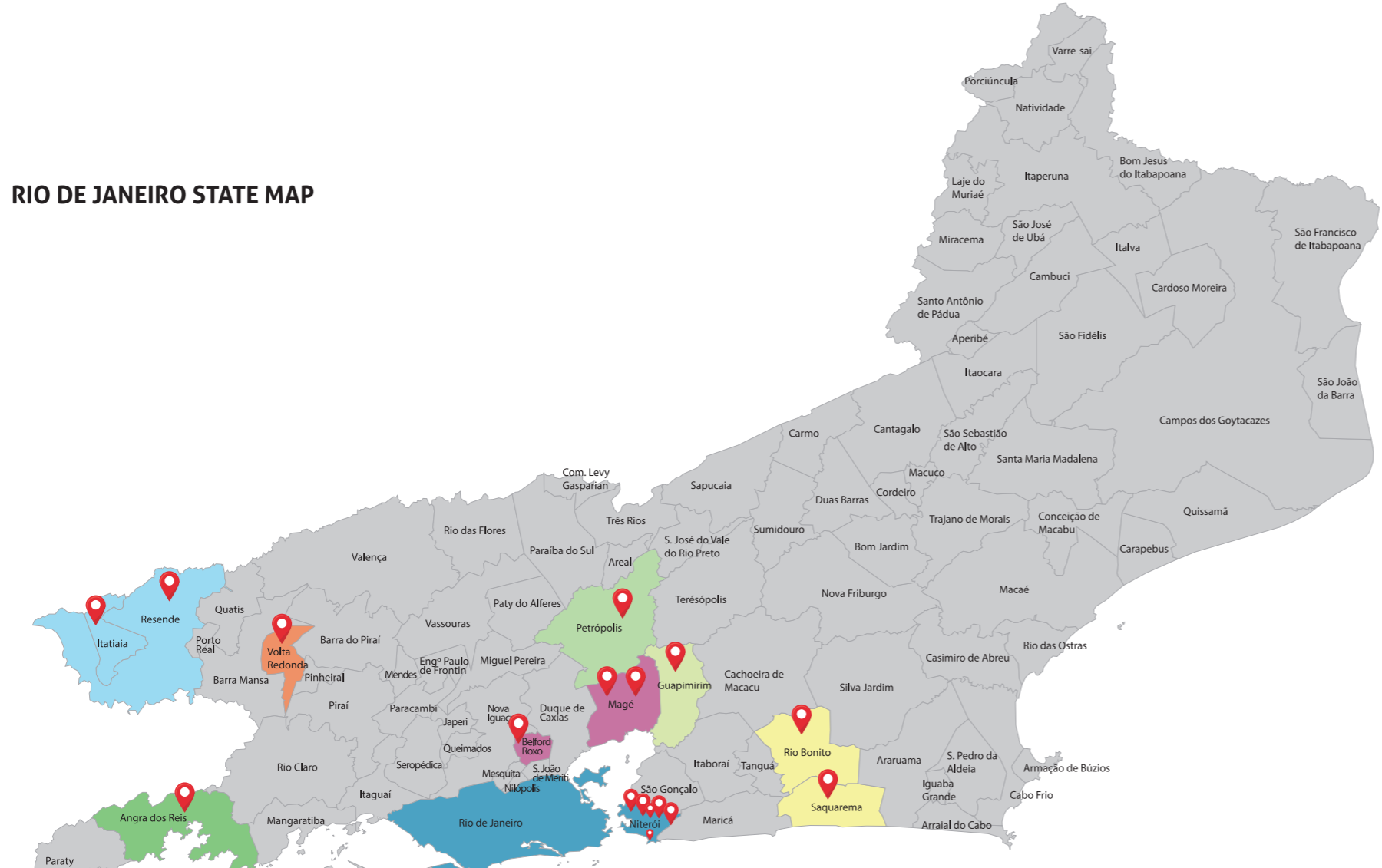

BOYS SCOUTS AND GIRL GUIDES MONUMENTS IN RIO DE JANEIRO STATE

- RIO DE JANEIRO**
- FIRST SCOUT HEADQUARTERS OF BRAZIL**
13 Chichorro Street
Front of the headquarters of the Boys Scouts from Brazil opened in 1910 by petty officers of the Brazilian Navy from England.
 - "THE SCOUT" Statue**
Luís de Camões Square - Glória
Inaugurated at Flamengo Beach in 1923, it was a gift from Chile to the Brazilian scouts through the donation sent by Brazilian children to help the victims of an earthquake. Created by artist Fernando Thauby. There is another twin statue in Chile.
 - TRIBUTE TO OLAVO BILAC**
Flower Market
Inaugurated by the Union of Boy Scouts of Brazil, in 1926, to honor the poet Olavo Bilac, one of the great diffusers of Brazilian scouting in its first decades. Located at Rosário Street with Olavo Bilac Square, flower market.
 - BADEN- POWELL SQUARE**
Leblon
The square was inaugurated by Mayor Negrão de Lima in 1957, the year the city hosted the 2nd Ajuri National Scout, on Governador Island, with 24,000 participants, and the 4th Inter-American Girl Scout Conference. That year was the centenary of the birth of Baden-Powell and the 50th anniversary of Scouting.
 - BADEN-POWELL BUST**
Luís de Camões Square - Glória
The bust of the founder of scouting and guidism was made by the artist Vicenzo Larocca, inaugurated in 1960, on the occasion of the 50th anniversary of the movement's implementation in Brazil. It was the 2nd bust of BP in South America.
 - TIME CAPSULE**
Franklin Roosevelt Avenue - Castelo
The obelisk was inaugurated in 1969 to commemorate the 50th anniversary of the Guidism Movement in Brazil with children's messages. Opened at the FBB Centennial celebrations in 2019, it will carry new messages for the future.
 - BADEN-POWELL CITY SCHOOL**
Guadalupe
Public School honoring (or pays tribute to) the founder of Scouting and Guiding.
 - ALMIRANTE BENJAMIN SODRÉ STREET**
Laranjeiras
Honors one of the most famous organizers of the Brazilian Scouting the "Old Wolf".
 - MOORING BRIDGE ALMIRANTE BENJAMIN SODRÉ**
São João Fortress, Urca.
The bridge honors one of the most famous organizers of Brazilian scouting the "Old Wolf". The tribute was made in 2007 by the Superior School of War.
 - CULTURAL CENTER OF THE SCOUTING MOVEMENT**
112 March 1st. Street, Downtown.
The only cultural center dedicated to Scouting and Bandeirantism in Latin America. It was founded in 1985 and its mission is to spread the memory and culture of the Scouting. It offers exhibitions, space for research and events.
 - SCOUT REGION, OFFICE OF RIO DE JANEIRO**
18 Rodrigo Silva Street, 7th floor - Carioca
Official office of representation of the Union of the Brazilian Boy Scouts in the state of Rio de Janeiro, in this address since 1969.
 - FEDERATION OF BRAZILIAN GIRL GUIDES - FBB.**
186 Marechal Câmara Avenue, Castelo
Official office of Federation representation of Girl Guides of Brasil in the Rio de Janeiro state. The building was built with donations and through campaigns among young women. On site there is a Chapel Awarded Catholic internationally for its architecture.
 - LORD BADEN-POWELL STREET.**
Inhauma
Honors the founder of Scouting and Girl Scouting.
 - Lourdes de Lima Rocha Municipal School**
Road Aterrado do Leme, 3309 - Santa Cruz
Teacher and director of Brazilian Girl Scout, leader responsible for the consolidation of Girl Guides in Brazil.
 - BUST OF THE BOY SCOUT Victor Luiz Kehl**
Noble Hall of the Fluminense Football Club
Bust inaugurated in 24 of June 1936, during the Club birthday party. Tribute to Young Vitor, who passed away at the age of 14 and was a good example of Boy Scout of the group headquartered in the Fluminense FC.
 - JERONIYMA MESQUITA STREET**
Barra da Tijuca
Honors one of the founders of the Federation of Girl Guides of Brazil, by Brazilian Red Cross and The Pró Matre.
 - REITOR AZEVEDO OF AMARAL STREET**
Downtown
Honouring the former National President of the Union of Brazilian Boy Scouts.
- NITERÓI**
- FEDERATION MILESTONE OF THE BRAZILIAN FEDERATION OF THE SEA SCOUTS**
Pier Square, Jurujuaba
The obelisk was inaugurated in 1991 which recalls the foundation of the Brazilian Federation of Sea Scouts in 1921, in that location.
 - MULTI-SPORT STADIUM CAIO MARTINS**
Presidente Backer Street, V/N - Icaraí
The municipal sports stadium of Niterói was inaugurated in 1941 honoring the Young Boy Scout of Minas Gerais on the initiative of the Governor of the State, Mr. Amaral Peixoto.

- STATUE OF CAIO MARTINS**
Located at the entrance of the Same name Stadium
The statue makes reference to the Young Scout of the Group Afonso Arinos, who was in the Train accident in Serra da Mantiqueira in 1938. The Goup helped to rescue many victims in the dark of the night and Caio Martins passed away the next day. The act of courage and altruism, in addition to other attitudes that came to be known after his death, made him revered as "Standard Boy Scout of the Brazil". Inaugurated in 1941.
 - BOA VIAGEM ISLAND**
Delivered in 1937 by the Brazilian Navy to the Sea Scouts, the island has the headquarters of the Sea Scout Group "Gaviões do Mar" and several allusive location to the Scout movement. It was named as "East Base" of the Sea Scouts in the Guanabara Bay.
 - ALMIRANTE BENJAMIN SODRÉ AVENUE**
Boa Viagem.
The avenue pays tribute to one of the most famous Brazilian Scouting organizers the "Old Wolf" exactly nearby his residence.
 - CHEFE ESCOTEIRO JARBAS PINTO RIBEIRO STREET**
Terrabrás, Engenho do Mato
Tribute to the oldest Scout of Brazil dead in 2012. Proposed by Councilor Carlos Magaldi, it was inaugurated in the same year.
 - BOY SCOUT SQUARE WALTER FOGAL**
166-192 Street, Santa Rosa
The square pays Tribute to the Young man Scout of the "Martim Afonso Group", who was recognized for his selflessness in helping the people in the downtown Streets, near the Councilors Chamber. Hit by a car passed away at the 1959, the Municipality gives his name to the square and donates the "Boy Scout mausoleum", in the Maruri cemetery, where it is buried Boy Scout Walter, and server all Boy Scouts who need it.
 - MILESTONE OF THE CENTENARY OF SCOUTING IN NITERÓI**
Horto do Fonseca, Barreto
The obelisk was inaugurated in 2017 honoring the centenary of the first Group formed in the municipality of Niterói.
- ANGRA DOS REIS**
- CHEFE COTTA SQUARE**
The square honors the Sea Scout chief who introduced Scouting in Angra dos Reis in 1948. Created three groups over the years. In the same square is the headquarters of the 12th Sea Scout Group, built by him.
- RIO BONITO**
- SCHOOL CAMP OR GIRL GUIDES**
Mineiros
The school camp serves to campsites and training of sessions for the girl guides of Brazil (FBB).
- RESENDE**
- SCOUT ITER DE SOUZA RIBEIRO STREET**
Ipiranga Park
The Street honors the Boy Scout of the 23rd Mauricio Ceoloto's Group passed away in 1978. Tribute made by Councilors Chambu of the Municipality.
- MAGÉ**
- SCOUT PAULO CESAR STREET**
Magemirim
- PACOPAIBA HOSTEL&CAMPING SCOUT**
- Morro Azul Road, São Francisco Street, 350 - Cruará Private area for boy scout camping.**
- GUAPIMIRIM**
- SCHOOL CAMP SCOUT CHIEF GERALDO HUGO NUNES**
Citroland
The filed was acquired in 1968 and pays tribute to the Chief Scout Geraldo Hugo Nunes, old presidente of the state Boy Scouts. With more than 10.000 hectares is na RPPN since 2009 and also servers to camps, courses, events and scientific surveys.
- VOLTA REDONDA**
- BOY SCOUT HOUSE**
Savio Cota de Almeida Gama Avenue - Retiro
Inaugurated in 2004 by Mayor Antonio Francisco Neto supports the scouting in the municipality contains a small museum and Hosts the 22nd São Judas Tadeu Group.
- BELFORD ROXO**
- Caio Vianna Martins Square**
Heliopolis
The square pays tribute to the Young Boy Scout who passed away in 1938 in a train accident.
- ITATIAIA**
- ITATIAIA BOYS SCOUT CHALET**
Itatiaia's National Park
Received as a donation by Federal Government the chalet Boys Scout Chalet Was in 1946. He received the 2st Course of Brazilian Wood Badge and is located inside the Itatiaia's National Park.
- SAQUAREMA**
- CHIEF'S FARM**
Road do Aterrado 2.130 Bacaxá
Private area for boy scout camping created in 2017.
- PETRÓPOLIS**
- TCHÊ FARM - SCOUT CAMP**
Posse, Petrópolis
Private area for boy scout camping.
